On Saturday & Sunday, August 8 & 9, eleven wineries along the Niagara Wine Trail USA will feature local artists and craftsman displaying and demonstrating their work at each winery.

Wine tasting will be available starting at 10am till 6pm on Saturday and noon till 6pm on Sunday. Each winery will have a different artist and/or craftsman. Some of the featured artists are Sean Manning with pottery at Freedom Run Winery, Valerie Richardson at The Winery at Marjim Manor, paintings by Michael Connelly and hand-painted porcelain by Rosemary Seivert at Niagara Landing Wine Cellars and Gail Rawlings at Schulze Vineyards & Winery.
