

Niagara Wine Trail Hosts Annual Festival – July 23-24, 2022

July 14, 2022 (Lewiston, NY) – The Niagara Wine Trail is bringing back its annual Wine Festival after a two-year pandemic hiatus. The two-day event takes place in Lewiston's Academy Park, Saturday, July 23, from 12 noon to 7 p.m., and Sunday, July 24, from 12 noon to 5 p.m., in Lewiston's Academy Park (851 Center St.). Tickets are on sale now at www.NiagaraWineTrail.org, for \$35 presale per person, or \$40 at the door. Designated drivers and non-drinking participants are welcomed at no charge.

"We are happy to bring back our festival once again," said Shane Gustafson, wine trail president and owner of A Gust of Sun Winery & Vineyard, in Ransomville, NY. "This is a great way to showcase our participating wineries all in one place."

Each festival ticket includes three tastes of wine from each of the participating wineries and a keepsake wine glass (while supplies last). Tickets are available for both days. Food or transportation is not included in the ticket price. DJ P Nasty will provide music throughout the festival. Participants can enter to win prizes throughout the two days (must be present to win).
